ROSENSTIEL AWARD

The Department of Atmospheric Sciences at the Rosenstiel School of the University of Miami, Miami, Florida, seeks nominations for the Rosenstiel Award. This annual award, created in 1971 by the Rosenstiel Foundation, will this year recognize outstanding contributions in the broad area of Atmospheric Sciences. General areas of interest include climate, forecasting at all time and spatial scales, extreme events, air-sea interactions, and atmospheric chemistry. Interdisciplinary expertise is also valued. The successful nominee will be a mid-career atmospheric scientist (10 to 20 years past their PhD) who in the past decade has made a significant contribution in a relevant research field and is expected to continue their impact into the future. The award includes a \$5,000 prize, and includes an in-person visit with a seminar and a reception. Please consider nominating a worthy colleague through providing the nominee's CV, a nomination letter that includes a statement of the candidate's major research contributions, and an ability to participate in-person.
